


Timeline of the e-invoicing legislation

	10 May 2017	XRechnung 1.0 Publication as XML in public administration (XÖV) standard in version 1.0 by the Coordination Office for IT Standards (KoSIT)
	22 June 2017	XRechnung adopted in Germany as the standard for electronic invoicing IT Planning Council adopts XRechnung as the new standard for electronic invoicing in Germany
	6 September 2017	Electronic Invoicing in Federal Government Public Procurement Ordinance Conclusion of the binding implementation of the European provisions and regulation for the e-invoicing obligation
	17 October 2017	European Norm EN 16931-1 Publication of the reference of the European Standard for electronic invoicing and the list of syntaxes in the Official Journal of the European Union
2018	27 November 2018	Implementation deadline for supreme federal authorities Deadline for receipt of XRechnung format invoices for supreme federal authorities and federal constitutional bodies
2020	18 April 2020	End of implementation period for states to accept electronic invoices 30 months after publication of the EU standard
	27 November 2020	Entry into force of supplier obligation at federal level
